

A Smile for Kids (ASK) works to empower under-resourced youth through orthodontics, education, and community service in Oregon. In partnership with 64 orthodontists, we fund braces for kids who otherwise would not be able to afford them and we focus on kids who have strong aesthetic needs who suffer from severe self esteem challenges. In 2019 we added 54 children to the ASK program, bringing the total children treated to 679 since our inception in 2004.

As part of the ASK requirements, grades must be lifted to a "C" level or above in order to start treatment, and each child is also required to provide 4 hours of community service in an organization in their local community.

As direct result of these requirements and the removal of a strong social barrier, kids in the ASK program graduate High School at a 94% rate and many continue to volunteer after their treatment has ended.

ASK works statewide with school counselors, health care professionals and social services to ensure that those supporting services understand how we can support their clients. We rely on these professionals to refer the kids to our program.
